
# AnMed: CCDR Super Stars

So proud of the AnMed team and their CCDR efforts!



# Diving into Disparities



### **Centering Black Voices:**

Factors Influencing a Cancer Patient's Decision to Join a Clinical Trial

This study, led by a medical student at the University of Maryland School of Medicine, is a cross-sectional descriptive study that aims to characterize key psychosocial factors to consider when enrolling in a

research study for patients who completed radiation treatment for curative gastrointestinal, thoracic, gynecological, and head and neck malignancies, with the goal of improved recruitment among Black patients; therefore helping research staff implement best practical approaches to increase Black participants in clinical research trials.
